JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: **Millwright** **(Non-Exempt)**

Job Reports To: **Foreman**

Job Summary:

Position with primary responsibility for the layout and installation of equipment. Responsibilities include but not limited to installation of equipment, rigging of equipment, ductwork, steel work, replacement and installation of bearings, drives, and rolls including alignment capabilities.

Essential Job Functions:

- Understand and communicate crane signals.
- Understand rigging and lifting points of equipment, ductwork and steel.
- Transport equipment by mechanical means, skating, and mobile equipment through outside and indoor facilities.
- Remove and install equipment/ductwork, and steel with chainfalls and cum-a-longs.
- Understanding the replacement and installation of bearings, drives, and rolls.
- Ability to fit and tack pieces independently or with fixtures.
- Understand the function of welding machines and can set-up a machine for various job requirements.
- Operate equipment as described in company procedures; i.e. metal cutting saws, cutting with torches and plasmas, drills, weld gauges, material handling equipment and grinders.
- Grind and perform various joint preparations.

Other Functions:

- Painting
- Grouting and anchoring of equipment.
- Layout and understand optical equipment.
- Ability to fit and install pipe by threading and/or Ability to weld utilizing stick, MIG, and/or TIG; sequence welds to prevent distortion during welding.

In addition to the functions listed above, the employee is expected to: strive to exhibit and apply GSI's attributes, exercise honesty, integrity and respect with all clients and co-workers, maintain a professional appearance and demeanor, demonstrate a positive attitude, communicate effectively with co-workers and clients, work with accuracy, efficiency, and attention to detail, maintain good attendance by working when and where directed, work safely in compliance with all safety policies, respect the work environment and keep it as neat and clean as possible, and exercise initiative to learn new skills and tasks and to help co-workers when possible. **The employee is also expected to perform such other duties and functions as required and assigned from time to time.**

The Physical Requirements Checklist that specifies the physical demands for this job is attached and is incorporated into this description.

Qualifications:

- Basic reading and writing skills; tape measure reading

Preferable Qualifications:

- Basic welding skills
- Minimum of 2 years work experience in a related position
- Certification in rigging, crane signals, forklift and telescopic forklifts
- Fluent in reading mechanical blueprints with the ability to interpret shop drawings and understand weld symbols

Machines/Tools/Equipment:

Metal cutting saws, cutting torches and plasmas, drills, weld gauges, material handling equipment and grinders.

Must be able to operate safety equipment, construction vehicles (forklifts, aerial & scissor lifts, etc.)

Working Conditions:

Extensive travel by vehicle; significant work at construction job sites, during all stages, in all types of weather conditions.

Must be able to perform activities requiring use of arms and legs, including climbing ladders/scaffolding, lifting & handling materials, walking & balancing, stooping.

Must be able to speak & understand detailed information through oral communication and be able to see clearly and recognize small details.
